Since our first donation on 25th November 2025, we have been able to provide an incredible 2,470 essential items to families with babies and young children, following professional referrals ensuring help reaches those who need it most.

These donations include pre-loved clothing, blankets, and everyday essentials, giving them a second life and keeping thousands of items out of landfill. Alongside this, thanks to our Christmas Crib fundraising, every Moses basket we gifted came with a brand new mattress, ensuring babies have a safe, clean place to sleep.

Every item donated, every hour worked by volunteers, and every act of kindness is helping families feel supported, and it's all made possible by our generous local community. Together, we're not just giving items, we're helping break the cycle of poverty and build brighter tomorrows.

Christmas Crib Fund Impact

Thanks to the incredible generosity of our supporters during the Christmas Crib fundraiser, we were able to purchase over 20 premium mattresses for families in need. These funds made a real difference, allowing us to provide brand-new, firm, safe-sleep-compliant mattresses, each of a high standard and backed by a one-year warranty from the date of purchase. Knowing that every baby has a safe and comfortable place to sleep is something we couldn't have achieved without your support.

We are committed to providing the safest sleep environment for every baby. The Lullaby Trust advises that babies should always sleep on a new, firm, flat mattress. Used or second-hand mattresses may carry hidden damage, contaminants, or fail to meet current safety standards, which increases the risk of sudden infant death. For this reason we are unable to accept any preloved mattresses. While providing new mattresses comes at an additional cost to the baby bank, it ensures we follow best practice and help keep every baby safe.

MATERNITY DIGNITY TOILETRIES PROJECT

You may have seen our Maternity Dignity Toiletries Project on our social media or website. We currently aim to provide standard Maternity Dignity Packs to all mums in need, we are hoping to upgrade every pack to an Enhanced Maternity Dignity Pack.

The Enhanced Pack builds on the Standard Pack, providing additional comfort, dignity, and longer-term wellbeing support for parents during hospital stays and recovery at home. Includes everything in the Standard Maternity Dignity Pack, plus brand new pyjamas for comfort and dignity during recovery. Slippers for warmth and safety on maternity wards. Socks to add comfort during hospital stays. Sustainable period underwear, reduces ongoing costs and period poverty. Small gentle skincare item for comfort, self-care, and wellbeing.

The Enhanced Pack recognises that parents experiencing financial hardship deserve the same standard of comfort and care as any other family entering maternity services.

We are currently fundraising to provide the sustainable, reusable period knickers with each hospital toiletries kit for mums. These items provide comfort, dignity, and hygiene, reducing landfill while saving families around £50–£80 per year on disposable products.
